

EFFECTIVE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMME

The Delivery Model

In order to achieve outputs it is proposed that as there are 6 courses delivered per year each with a minimum of 10 delegates- therefore providing 60 delegates per year trained. This provision will be offered as half day / twilight sessions on a flexible delivery basis.

The course will consist of 4 modules and will culminate in a **half-day placement** with a host school in order to begin to practice and explore practical partnership leading to potential long-term relationships between employers and schools. In matching schools with employers attention will be paid to specialist status of schools, the emerging specialist diploma provision and areas where there is a need to enhance or begin to embed an enterprise culture.

The course is officially endorsed by the Institute of Healthcare Management IHM.

The 4 modules will be:

Module 1 Induction to the programme and Education Update

Module 2 Child Protection and Related Legislation

Module 3 Managing and Working in the School Environment

Module 4 Effective Presentation Skills in the School Environment

Each programme will have 4 modules and a placement as outlined on the attached sheets and delegates who successfully complete the course will receive a certificate. The certificate together with the completion of the portfolio will serve to give evidence of competence should a delegate wish to achieve accreditation in relevant provision.

The course will be co-ordinated through **Jacqui Jameson Associates** and all tutors will have relevant expertise to ensure that up-to-date and leading edge knowledge is imparted to delegates.

COURSE OUTLINE

Aim

To establish mutual understanding of the employer and school sector and by doing so promote and encourage a sustainable partnership between local employers and host schools in order to strengthen enterprise and vocational provision.

Objectives:

To develop and promote a course for employers, which will:

- provide delegates with underpinning skills and knowledge about the education sector and relevant legislation and strategies
- encourage employers to consider how they could collaborate with local schools and so offer mutually beneficial interventions. Whereby the school gain insight into relevant occupational sectors and employers gain an accurate picture of education, in order to influence the curriculum in line with industry standards and emerging employer needs.
- enhance networking and partnership between schools and employers through an increased understanding and appreciation of complementary support, which could be provided to young people, with particular focus on the enterprise and vocational provision.

- build on existing skills of employers to support them in making effective interventions within local schools.
- provide delegates with and opportunity to gain some elements of underpinning knowledge related to accredited qualifications.

The courses will all be delivered at the **Express Holiday Inn near the M18** in Doncaster unless other notification given. In addition delegates will undertake a school placement which will be negotiated on an individual basis.

The modules will be delivered as a combination of **breakfast and twilight sessions**, with each session lasting no longer than **3 hours**. **Breakfast sessions will commence at 8am and finish at 11am, twilight sessions will commence at 4pm and finish at 7pm.**

Appropriate refreshments and food will be provided at each session. In addition, companies will be able to claim for a set amount to contribute to the **cover expenses** incurred for attendance. Details of this will be provided for each course.
