### ***Year 9 'Bright Futures' Enterprise day at the Keepmoat Stadium October 2007***

The entire Year group spent a day at the Keepmoat Stadium working with the 'Bright Futures' team. Students worked in teams to complete a series of challenges involving communication, problem solving and team work. This was part of our 'Northern Way' enterprise project in consortium with Balby Carr, Edlington and Mexborough schools. Well done to all of the students selected to present their work – described by our business dragons as the highest standard they have seen in several years running this type of activity.
