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Why do a business placement?

- If you are seeking to move to a SMT role, you can benefit from a placement where you can see how business management operates.
- To develop art and drama, you can benefit from a placement with radio stations, theatres, printing companies, newspapers, etc.
- To enhance pupils' knowledge and understanding of environmental change and sustainable development, you could benefit from a placement in a company involved in recycling and ecological protection.
- Teachers wanting to make their maths teaching relevant to the world can use their placement to bring real maths problems from business into the classroom.

Who can do a placement?

Teachers, teaching assistants, school managers and learning mentors can all participate.

When can I do a placement?

At a time that suits both you and the business.

How long does the placement last?

One to five days.

What do I need to do?

1. Get the support of your SMT
2. Contact us to arrange the placement
3. Go on the placement
4. With our help, do a case study on the business
5. Develop a classroom task or resource

What happens next?
